Then the father said to him, "Son, you are always with me, and all that is mine is yours. But we had to celebrate and rejoice, because this brother of yours was dead and has come to life; he was lost and has been found." (Luke 15: 31-32)

This Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Lent and in Sunday's Gospel (Luke 15: 1-3, 11- 32) we are reminded of the story of the Prodigal Son. When we reflect on the Gospel many of us think that the son who spent his inheritance was greedy and wasteful and the son who remained with the Father was well within his right to be put out by the Father's great welcoming home of this 'waster'. It certainly stirs up many feelings of inequality for the 'good son', however, while we are side tracked and wrapped up in these feelings we are missing the real focus of the Gospel which is that of a loving, forgiving, merciful father. It could be seen that neither of the sons are worthy of their father's love. One turned his back on that love and the other expected it as a rightful due. How often in life are we guilty of coveting that of others instead of being grateful for our own blessings?

When we reflect on this Gospel let us be reminded of our own loving, forgiving, merciful father; God. Let us all take time to reflect on our merciful Father who loves us not because we have earned His love, but instead, loves us despite our failings and inadequacies. Our Father loves us because our Father loves us! Nothing we do can win that love and nothing we can possibly do will lose it. Our Father forgives despite what we have done and what we have failed to do. Our merciful Father forgives us because He loves us and always will. And for this we should rejoice!

This year, St Francis School will join Catholic schools across NSW and the ACT to celebrate Catholic Schools Week (CSW) from 6 -10 March. The theme for CSW 2016 is 'I Belong, You Belong, We Belong'.
