Family Connection

During the season of Advent, we choose to add many activities to our family's schedule to prepare for our celebration of Christmas. John the Baptist reminds us that our repentance is another way in which we can prepare for the Lord's coming and our celebration of Christmas.

Read together today's Gospel, Luke 3:1-6. Talk about how John the Baptist called upon the people to prepare the way of the Lord through repentance. Together as a family, prepare a simple reconciliation service in preparation for Christmas. Gather in a prayerful space, perhaps around the family Advent wreath. Read again from today's Gospel, Luke 3:1-6. Invite each family member to pray silently, asking God to forgive his or her sins. Then celebrate God's forgiveness by sharing the sign of peace with one another.

2016 SCHOOL UNIFORMS

As of next year the St Francis of Assisi boys summer school uniform will be changing. It will be compulsory for boys starting Kindergarten 2016 to be in the new school uniform while the other students will have a two year change over period. The boys will now be wearing navy blue shorts, a yellow shirt that has the school logo embroidered on it and navy socks.

The boys uniforms will be supplied by OZ Fashions (the supplier of our current sports uniform) who will be at St Francis School for two days during the school holidays to purchase the new boys uniform as well as reduced prices on black leather shoes and white joggers. (sent home with newsletter).

The girls summer uniforms are the same and still available from Lowes.

Next year it is **COMPULSORY** that all students have a St Francis of Assisi Primary School Bag. These can be bought from the office. There are currently 3 styles available that cater for Kindergarten to Year 6.

BUS PASS (SCHOOL OPAL CARDS)

As of next year the School Opal Card will replace the normal bus pass. Please remind your child that when they catch a bus that they will need to **'TAP ON'** and **'TAP OFF'**.

If your child is in Year 2 this year and requires a bus pass next year, they need to apply for a new bus pass. Busways will not automatically send out a bus pass for students in Year 3 2016, as the criteria to be eligible for a bus pass changes. If your child needs a bus pass for next year please contact the school office for an application form.



COSHC VACATION CARE

COSHC will be offering Vacation Care during the January holidays 2016. If your children currently attend the COSHC and you require Vacation Care, a form needs to be completed and payment made to COSHC before the 11th December 2015. If your child doesn't currently attend COSHC but you require vacation care then you will also need to fill out a vacation care form as well as a new enrolment form and have the payment finalised by the 11th December.
