Dear Parents

Last Sunday's gospel recounted when Jesus observed rich people giving large sums of money to the church while also noticing a poor widow give two coins, the equivalent of a penny. Jesus states that the rich gave what they had left over, however, he is touched that while the widow didn't give a large amount she did give all she had. This required a great deal of trust in God. How would she survive the next day without money? She believed that God would provide for her.

People watching at the temple treasury that day may have thought that the widow had given nothing worthwhile. They may have even thought that they could manage quite well without her apparently paltry contribution. Jesus saw things differently. She put in more than all the others because she gave herself fully without holding back.

Jesus in this gospel encourages every one of us to give ourselves in love to the building of his Kingdom. He needs us all, and we need each other. We need the old and the young, we need the well and the sick, we need everyone's love to support us in our faith and hope as we strive to draw closer to Jesus.

We have ourselves to give, if we offer to the community our small amount of love, our small amount of time, our small amount of patience and experience - and we offer it as best we can with all our heart. Jesus will see, even if no one else does.

Let us trust in God and give of ourselves.
