Term I Week 3

Parents are required by law to ensure that children aged between 6 and 17 attend school. Schools are required to monitor and keep a register of student attendance in accordance with common codes, which explain student absences.

Students who are absent from school may be disadvantaged in their learning and development. To maximise the benefits of education for all students, schools are required to follow legislative requirements of the Education Act 1990 to monitor student attendance effectively.

EXEMPTIONS

Previous **Exemption from attendance** no longer applies to travel and holidays, both domestically and internationally. You no longer need to apply to the school for an exemption from education.

New changes to attendance 2015

The following outlines the changes that have been implemented as a result of the changes to the Education Act 1990 regarding attendance. These changes take effect immediately.

New requirements for student absence and travel

1-9 days absence: Parents MUST notify the teacher or Principal) by mail or email (it needs to be written).

10-100 days absence: Parents must complete and submit the **Application for Extended Leave** form (**on school website**) prior to commencing leave. If approved the Principal issues a Certificate of Extended Leave. If the Principal declines the application (i.e. it is not within the best interest of the child to take leave and be absent from school), a letter notifying the parents that the application has been declined would be forthcoming.

ALLERGIES

With the growing number of children in our schools with nut allergies, we need to be more mindful of the harm such allergies can cause to some students in our school.

We kindly ask that you refrain from sending any items in the lunch box containing tree nuts such as almonds, peanut butter or nutella.

We ask for your support in this matter as the reaction to such products can be life threatening for those who have an allergy.

DID YOU KNOW?

On average, it costs around \$13,000 per year to educate a child in a NSW school.

In most Catholic Schools, school fees cover less than a quarter of this cost.

The rest comes from taxpayers like you!

This is why funding support from Federal & State Governments must keep pace with rising education costs—to maintain education quality and to ensure a Catholic education remains affordable for all families.
