#### **Gospel Reading**

Term 4 Week 8 - 27th November 2015

Luke 21:25-28,34-36

Jesus teaches his disciples to be vigilant so that they will be ready when the Son of Man comes in glory.

#### **Family Connection**

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus warns his disciples against the fatigue that can emerge if one becomes consumed by the anxieties of daily life. Many families are too familiar with the kind of fatigue Jesus refers to here. We may be concerned about a family member's health, our job security, our children's education, or any number of other concerns. All these are important matters. Jesus does not promise an end to daily worries and fears, but he does teach his disciples that they will have the strength to withstand anxiety if they stay focused on him, remaining vigilant for his return and praying for strength to endure all tribulations. Through prayer, God helps us stay focused on that which is most important in our lives.

As you gather as a family, recall the tradition of making New Year's resolutions in preparation for the new calendar year. Observe that today is the first Sunday of Advent, which is the beginning of the new Church year. During the season of Advent, our Gospel readings ask us to consider what is most important to us as we prepare for Jesus' coming, at his birth and at the end of time.

I am very pleased to be back in Australia and here with the St Francis community. My experiences were amazing in Amman, Tiberius, Jerusalem, Rome and Assisi. Our Pilgrimage group visited many places and celebrated Mass together. To be able to follow in the footsteps of Jesus Christ was a great privilege. I was fortunate as I spent two nights in Assisi, which was very special as it is where St Francis lived and worked and spread the message about the importance of peace in the world, which at this present time is so important.

I also put prayer intentions of the St Francis community in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the place where Jesus was buried.


