Dear Parents

In this Sunday's gospel we hear Jesus tell a story to warn us about people with great pride. In his parable two men are in the temple praying. One man is very self-righteous and in the action of praying he tells God how good he is and that he is better than the tax collector. In essence he is saying that he doesn't need God. His pride stops him from seeing his own faults. At the same time another man recognises himself as a sinner and prays to God for mercy. In his humility he says how much he needs God. Jesus tells us that God hears the prayers of the humble and is merciful to them.

This year, Pope Francis has called us to celebrate this mercy of God through a special Jubilee Year of Mercy. We are reminded of God's great desire to bestow love and forgiveness upon us and we are asked to live this example by showing kindness and compassion to others.

This week our school was privileged to host the Cross of Mercy and the Holy Relics of both St. Mary of the Cross MacKillop and St. Teresa of Kolkota. These two saints were a great example of humility that Jesus talks about in this week's gospel.

Students attended a liturgy on Tuesday afternoon where they showed great reverence and placed their own prayer of mercy at the foot of the Cross of Mercy. The Cross and Holy Relics have travelled throughout the diocese as a means of uniting parishes and schools in this Jubilee Year of Mercy, renewing us in our call to be ambassadors of mercy in God's name.

It is up to us to respond to Sunday's Gospel and live a life of humility asking for mercy and showing that same mercy to those we meet. This is not an easy task.
