Dear Parents

STUDENT BUS PASSES

Applications for 2018 School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) and Term Bus Pass (TBP) travel entitlements are now open.

In coming days students who hold an SSTS entitlement and are changing grades from Year 2 to 3 or Year 6 to Year 7 and changing school, and students whose entitlement was approved under a medical condition, will receive notification by email or post informing them of the pending expiry of their entitlement. TBP holders will also receive notification.

Applications need to be made before 31 December 2017 to ensure the students entitlement is updated and their current card is not cancelled. If the application is made after the expiry, the system will automatically cancel the card and new one will need to be issued.

PLEASE NOTE: if you are **NOT** changing from grade 2 to 3 and are staying at the same school you do not need to reapply.

Students in the Opal area who are applying for a SSTS or TBP entitlement or the first time will receive their card a week or two before school starts in 2018.
