Dear Parents

In this Sunday's gospel we hear Jesus tell a story to warn us about people with great pride. In his parable two men are in the temple praying. One man is very self-righteous and in the action of praying he tells God how good he is and that he is better than the tax collector. In essence he is saying that he doesn't need God. His pride stops him from seeing his own faults. At the same time another man, a tax collector recognises himself as a sinner and prays to God for mercy. In his humility he says how much he needs God. Jesus tells us that God hears the prayers of the humble and is merciful to them.

It is up to us to respond to Sunday's Gospel and live a life of humility asking for mercy and showing that same mercy to those we meet. This is not an easy task. Good luck this week living out the Gospel!

BUSWAYS BUSES IN WESTERN SYDNEY ARE GOING CASHLESS

From Monday October 28 2019, Busways' Western Sydney buses will no longer accept cash payments.

- Students can use their School Opal card to get to and from their destination during the week. On the weekend, they will need to use their Child/Youth Opal card to pay for their journey.
- Parents of the students and friends of the school can pay using their Opal card, credit card, debit card or linked device. Travel benefits apply to all when using the same card consistently.
- Opal cards are available online and over the counter from retailers including most newsagents, post offices, convenience stores and supermarkets.
- Remember to separate your cards so your preferred card is charged when tapping on and tapping off.

- Send me to school if ...
 I have the symptoms of a cold or hayfever
 I have a sprain, strain or pain and I can function (walk, talk and eat)
 If I have asthma, diabetes, epilepsy etc school personnel are trained to manage my condition. Talk to the school about my health plan I haven't vomited or had diarrhoea for 24 hours

If I am sick please call the school or write me a note to let the school know why I am not at school.

- Keep me home if ... I have a temperature higher than 37 degrees I am vomiting or have diarrhoea My eyes are red, and crusty (conjunctivitis)
- I have influenza (flu) combination fever, sore throat, cough,
