PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all the families who were able to meet with their child's teacher and receive up-to-date information on the progress their child is making with their learning at this stage. Our intention in having the interviews before the reports come out is so that parents, teachers and students have the opportunity to discuss, not only their child's achievements, but also the challenges or gaps in their learning and then together setting their learning goals for the next semester. We believe that the discussion between parents, teachers and students is invaluable, particularly because this allows us to work together to improve learning outcomes without the necessity of having to wait until the end of Term 2 when the first semester report is published. It is important that together as partners in your child's education we consult on a regular basis, both formally and informally. Communication is vital to building strong relationships and as we know the success of your child involves all of us working together, communicating openly about your child's learning and their wellbeing at school.

SAFETY FOR ALL

Schools continue to be on alert for the signs of COVID. Please see the NSW Health Guidelines below for students returning to school after an illness (NB these guidelines have not changed):

- Students must not attend school if they are unwell. This includes even minor flu symptoms
- Should a student be absent due to a sore throat or flu like symptoms they must return a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom free before returning to school
- Schools must sight the negative COVID -19 test prior to allowing students to return to school
- If you do not wish your child to undertake a COVID -19 test or provide the school with a negative test result, the guidelines are that the student is to be excluded from school for a 10-day period. Additionally the student must be symptom free for at least 3 days before returning to school
- If your child has complex health issues please have your child assessed by your medical practitioner. Where a medical practitioner determines that a COVID-19 test is not required, a medical certificate must be provided to the school to confirm that the student does not have symptoms that warrant a COVID-19 test. The certificate must also indicate that the student is able to return to the school environment.

Thank you for your continued cooperation in ensuring the safety of all students and staff at St Francis.

SCHOOL BANKING - THURSDAY



School Banking has now started and our banking day is **Thursday.**

For each weekly deposit made at school, students will receive a Dollarmites token. Once they collect 10 tokens, they can redeem them for a School Banking reward.

If your child has previously participated in School Banking, or has an existing Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account, they can start banking straight away by bringing their Dollarmites deposit wallet to school on School Banking day.

If your child has lost their deposit wallet, please contact your School Banking Co-ordinator or visit any Commonwealth Bank branch for a replacement.

If your child doesn't have a Commonwealth Bank account you will need to open one before they can start banking. You can do this at any Commonwealth Bank branch.
